DIRECTIONS TO SHOW SITE

From the East/West (via Ohio Turnpike) Take Ohio Turnpike to exit 152
(St Rt 10 Lorain Rd. exit. Turn right (East) on Lorain Rd
Soccer Sportsplex 2 miles on your right

From the East (via I-480) Take I-480 West to exit 2 –Lorain Rd
(about 8 miles west of I-71) At the intersection
turn right into the Soccer Sportsplex (less than 1/3 mile

From the North Take I-71 south to I-480.split (need to be in left lane)
Take I-480 west to Exit 2 – Lorain Rd (about 8 miles)
At the intersection turn right into the
Soccer Sportsplex (less than 1/3 mile)

From the South Take I-71 north to I-480 Toledo exit. Take I-480 west
to exit 2 Lorain Rd (about 8 miles).At the intersection
turn right into the Soccer Sportsplex (less than 1/3 mile)

From Sawmill Creek Resort it's about 45 miles to the north Olmstead Soccer Sportsplex, so plan on a 50 minute drive

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

- The safety of the dogs is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.
- **Dogs under the age of 4 months are not permitted on the show grounds of AKC Agility Trials.**
- Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that the dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by the action of the show committee. No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, and act of God, public emergency, act of a public person be pe enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.
- Refunds minus \$6.00 per run will be given to bitches in season and all dogs that can't compete due to injury upon receipt of an excuse from a licensed veterinarian written on his/her letterhead. No other refunds will be issued.
- Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. There will be a \$25.00 service charge for returned checks.
- It is expressly understood that the exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Show Committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such case, no refund of any entry fees paid will be made.
- Exhibitors are responsible for being at the ring gate when it is their turn to run.
- Dogs must be on leash AT ALL TIMES except when in the ring or when in designated agility jump warm-up areas. This will be strictly enforced.
- Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.
- This club does not agree to arbitrate claims as set forth on the Official AKC Entry Form for this event
- Food will be available for purchase on site
- Dog potty areas – use only designated potty areas. Dogs are not allowed to relieve themselves on the shrubbery in front of the building or on the building
- Keep our site beautiful - CLEAN UP is mandatory both INSIDE and OUTSIDE the Sportsplex. Anyone not cleaning up after their dogs ANYWHERE will be reported to the show committee.
- Sportsplex has a policy of one cake allowed per day and only for MACH's. The person bringing the cake for plates, napkins, forks and prompt clean up.
- Crating space is provided in and around the one ring used for the trial. No crating in the center aisle or around any unused ring.
- Plastic/tarp must be placed under crates and ex-pens, chairs, water bowls. No straight legged chairs on soccer turf.
- Food available on site – Food can only be eaten in food court. No outside food can be brought in.
- NO smoking inside the Soccer Sportsplex. NO bitches in season permitted.
- NO grooming allowed on the Soccer Sportsplex property inside or outside.
- Air conditioner works very well. Bring a sweatshirt if you are a “freeze baby”! Reactive dogs will be asked to move or be covered.
- Exhibitors and their dogs are NOT allowed on the fenced grass soccer field at any time.
- Respect neighbor businesses and keep your dogs on Sportsplex property in designated areas
- Once the Sunday CABTC trial is over, there will be no set up for Monday. The Soccer Sportsplex may be open for other events, but they have been informed to not allow exhibitors to set up after hours.

CLASS DESCRIPTIONS

Please see the AKC Regulations for Agility Trials for current class descriptions. Dogs must be entered only in Regular Classes or Preferred Classes with no cross-over between them allowed at the same set of trials.

MEASURING and HEIGHT CARD INFORMATION

Effective January 1, 2010, exhibitors are no longer required to provide proof to Trial Secretaries that their dog has a valid jump height card as part of the check-in process. Furthermore, this change eliminates the need for a copy of the jump height card to be submitted with an entry form.

Dogs without a valid Jump Height Card/Form may still compete; but they must be measured/wicketed by the **Judge of Record** PRIOR to running in their class and this measurement will be valid for that weekend of trials only. The exception to this requirement is a dog entered in the 24” height division. However, if a **Volunteer Measuring Official (VMO)** or an **Agility Field Rep** is present; **ALL** dogs without a valid Jump Height Card/Form must be measured at some time during the trial or cluster of trials. This does not preclude having the dog wicketed by the Judge of Record if the VMO or Rep is not available to measure the dog **before** its first run of the trial or cluster of trials. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog measured prior to running and failure to do so will result in the cancellation of any qualifying scores.

ENTRY LIMITS

250 runs per day.

Non-Regular ISC Classes will not be offered at these trials.

ENTRY FEES

\$25.00 for first entry, \$18.00 for second entry in the same event number, Make checks payable to CWCCA.

Entry fees include AKC recording fee of \$3.50 for the first entry of each dog, and \$3.00 for each additional entry of the same dog per event.

ACCEPTANCE & CONFIRMATION OF ENTRIES

Receipt of entry will be emailed to those providing a legible email address. Confirmation letters and judging schedule will be sent out as soon as possible after closing of the trial.

Express/overnight entries mailed without signature waiver may be returned

DOGS ELIGIBLE TO ENTER

This trial is open to all dogs 15 months and older that are registered with the American Kennel Club, or that have an AKC limited registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing privileges (PAL/ILP) or an AKC Canine Partners listing number, or approved Foundation Stock Service (FSS) breeds except bitches in season, aggressive dogs, blind or deaf dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance.

OBSTACLES

COURSE FAMILIARIZATION

Handlers in all classes are permitted to walk the course, without a dog, prior to the start of their class. All walk-throughs are restricted to the handlers entered in that class.

RIBBONS AND PRIZES

- Qualifying Ribbons will be awarded for each qualifying score earned.
- Placement rosettes will be awarded for 1st through 4th place in each class, jump height and in each division.
- Each dog entered will receive a fleece tug.
- Each exhibitor will receive a tervis mug with logo..
- A MACH bar and MACH rosette will be awarded to anyone earning a MACH title. A PACH bar and PACH rosette will be awarded to anyone earning a PACH title

High In Trial Awards

Trial #2 awarded to a Novice A Handler (This can be either from the Novice A classes or the preferred classes

High in Trial is based on total points earned. Each dog is assigned points based on the standard level entered. (30 -EX/MAST, 20- OPEN, 10- NOV). Qualifying runs in both JWW & STD earn speed points (judge's STC - dog's course time (rounded down)). HIT is the dog with the most points.

Additionally, I (we) hereby assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify, defend, and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expense (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damage because of bodily injuries, including death at any time resulting therefrom, sustained by any person or persons, including myself (ourselves), or on account of damage to property, arising out of or in consequence of my (our) participation in this event, however such, injuries, death or property damage may be caused, and whether or not the same may have been caused or may be alleged to have been caused by negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees or agents, or any other persons.

INSTRUCTIONS

Handlers may opt to enter in a higher **height division** for all **Regular** titling classes, but not in a division lower than their proper height division. Dogs entered in the **Preferred** classes **must** compete at the required jump height and **may not** compete in a jump height division **higher or lower** than their proper height division.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an **Agility Jump Height Card** may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. If measured by the Judge of record, that measurement will be valid for this trial *or back-to-back trials* only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.

Dogs listed in the **AKC Canine PartnersSM** program may be eligible to enter all-breed AKC agility trials at the club's option. These dogs should be listed as All American Dog and must include their AKC number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box. **Junior Handlers** should enter their Junior Handler number on the front of this form. Should you not have your Junior Handler number, it may be obtained from the American Kennel Club (919) 233-9767. If the Junior Handler is not the owner of the dog identified on the face of this form, what is the relationship of the Junior Handler to the Owner?

I CERTIFY that I am the actual owner of the dog, or that I am the duly authorized agent of the actual owner whose name I have entered above.
