In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog.

**INSTRUCTIONS**

1. **(Variety)** if you are entering a dog of a breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering, i.e., Cocker Spaniel (solid color, black, ASCOB, parti-color), Beagles (not exceeding 13 inches, over 13 inches but not exceeding 15 inches), Dachshunds (longhaired, smooth, wirehaired) Collies (rough, smooth) Bull Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy) Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature, standard).
2. The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs, which, according to their owner's records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.
3. **(Dog Show Class).** Consult the classification in this premium list. If the dog show class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class which you are entering your dog, i.e., age division, color division, weight division.
4. A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for a show closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any show for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his name. State on entry form whether transfer application has been mailed to AKC (For complete rule refer to Chapter 14, Section 3.)

## **ENTRY LIMITATIONS AND TEST INFORMATION**

In accordance with AKC Obedience Regulations entries in these tests will be accepted up to the official closing date and time, even though the advertised limits may have been reached. **Eligibility:** **TD:** All dogs possessing the title of TD, TDX, VST or who have passed a certification track by an authorized AKC Tracking Judge. **TDX:** All dogs possessing TD < TDX or VST.

Should the number of entries exceed the number of tracks available, a drawing to determine which entries will participate in the test will be held Thursday, March 31, 2011 at 8:00 PM at the Secretary's home, 10218 N. Laurel Branch Drive, Houston, Texas 77064. This drawing will be conducted by the Test Secretary and preference will be given to Cardigan Welsh Corgis without their title, then Cardigan Welsh Corgis with their title. The remaining slots will be open to all AKC registered breeds in accordance to Chapter 1 Section 13b of the Tracking Regulations.

When the advertised limit for each test has been drawn, all of the remaining entries shall be similarly drawn and assigned a position on the appropriate TD or TDX Alternates List, subject to the same preference set forth above. The Test Secretary shall than notify all entries of the results of the drawing. Alternates will be given the option to accept or decline being placed on the alternates list. Those who decline will have their entry fee and certification returned. Entrants and alternates who do not run but are replaced by an alternate who runs will have their entry fees and certifications returned.

In the event that either test does not fill its limit then the number of tracks may be substituted for the other test with the exchange being in the ratio of 2 TD tracks to 1 TDX track.

Entry fees will not be refunded in the event a dog is absent (*see below*), disqualified, excused by a veterinarian or judge or barred from participation by action of the Test Committee. ***Bitches in season may participate per Chapter 2, Section 8, Tracking Regulations.***

**Entry fees will be refunded for:** (a) an alternate who does not participate and (b) an entry who is absent by virtue of having earned, after the close of entries, the title for the test in which he is entered, **provided**, a properly entered alternate is available and runs said dog's track. Refunds will be mailed within seven (7) days following the test.

In the event an accepted entry cancels following the closing of entries, the Test Secretary shall contact alternates according to their placement on the Alternate List. Upon such notification, alternates shall have the option of accepting or refusing the opportunity to participate in the test.

In the event an accepted entry is absent on the day of the test, it shall be the responsibility of the Test Secretary to determine if alternates are present and by their position on the Alternates List, determine which of the alternates shall participate.

The assignment of dogs to the tracks, by the drawing of lots is the responsibility of the judges.

The CWCCA will exercise all reasonable care for the safety of dogs, handlers and spectators but will not be responsible for any loss, damage, or injury to any dog or person on the test grounds. Dog that are not competing in the trials will be instructed where to go and all dogs at this event shall be on a lead at all times.

The Cardigan Welsh Corgi Club of America, Inc opt out of the Arbitration Provision on the back of the AKC Official Entry Form for this event.
