## **CWCCA'S PROCEDURE FOR JUDGING BEST OF BREED COMPETITION**

Check in time for everyone entered in Best of Breed will be published in the Judging Program. This includes Winners Dog, Winners Bitch and First Place Winner in each of the Veteran Classes and Herding Titled Classes for both Dogs and Bitches.

Once the check in process is complete, judging will commence with the 1st group. It is the handlers' responsibility for tracking the progress of judging. No ring will be held for absent or late handlers.

The last group for the Best of Breed Competition will consist of the Non-Specials which include the Winners Dogs, Winners Bitch and the First Place Winners in each of the Veteran Classes and Herding Titled Classes for both the Dogs and the Bitches.

If someone has more than one entry and they fall into the same group, please make the ring stewards aware of this in order that everyone can be accommodated prior to the start of check in of Best of Breed Competition.

Group assignments will be posted at the armband table and ringside when they become available.

*Neutered dogs and spayed bitches may compete in the Veterans Classes at Independent Specialties. The winner of each of these classes will be eligible to compete for Best of Breed.*

\*HERDING TITLED DOG/BITCH CLASS - For any Cardigan Welsh Corgi that is over six (6) months of age that has acquired an AKC Herding Title of record will be eligible for this class. The winner of these classes will be eligible to compete for Best of Breed.

*Altered males or spayed bitches may NOT be exhibited in any single entry non-regular class except Veterans.*

If entered in Veteran or Herding Titled Classes, they may **NOT** be exhibited in BOB if they are defeated in either the Veteran or Herding Titled non-regular class.

Instinct tests are a certificate NOT a title and therefore do not qualify a dog for this class.

**Best Of Breed Competition:** The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed Competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and Dogs which according to their owners' records have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The entry and showing of dogs whose championships are unconfirmed is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where a dog completed the requirements for a championship according to the owners' records. If, at the end of the 90-day period, the championship of a dog has not been confirmed by AKC, no further entries of the dog for Best of Breed competition are to be made until its championship has been confirmed by AKC. Select Dog and Select Bitch, where applicable, will be awarded following Best of Breed.

**Judge's Award of Merit:** Immediately following the Best of Breed competition, the judge may select, at his discretion, up to 10% of the superior quality specimens from the intersex competition. These would not include those exhibits previously awarded Best of Breed, Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed, Select Dog/Bitch or Best of Winners.

**Amateur-Owner-Handler:** (AOH Class Eligibility) For dogs that are at least six (6) months of age on the first day of the show, that are not champions of record. Dogs must be handled in the class by the registered owner of the dog. This class is restricted to exhibitors who have not, at any point in time, been a professional dog handler, AKC approved conformation judge, or employed as an assistant to a professional handler. Additionally, members of the immediate family or household of a current professional handler are ineligible for this class (as defined in Chapter 11, Section 13).

**Bred-By-Exhibitor Class eligibility:** (BBE Class Eligibility) All dogs entered in the Bred-By-Exhibitor Class must be individually registered with AKC. Dogs must be at least six (6) months of age on the first day of the show and are not champions of record. All dogs in the class must be handled by the registered owner/breeder. Family members must be both a breeder and owner of record to exhibit in the class. In any subsequent classes for which dog from the Bred-by-Exhibitor Class becomes eligible, there are no restrictions as to who may handle.

**Best Puppy Competition:** During the course of regular judging, the assigned judge will select a Best Puppy from the Regular Puppy Class (6-9 months, 9-12 months) and Bred-By Exhibitor Puppy Class winners. This will be done after the Best of Breed Competition, unless the Best Puppy award is automatic. Example: An entry from the Puppy class is awarded Best of Winners or Best of Breed. Only dog and bitches undefeated in a Puppy class are eligible for Best Puppy competition. If the first-place winner is not present, the second-place winner may not compete. NO ADDITIONAL FEE IS REQUIRED.

**Best Bred-by-Exhibitor Competition:** During the course of regular judging, the assigned judge will select a Best Bred-By-Exhibitor from the Bred-By-Exhibitor Class winners. This will be done after the Best of Breed Competition, unless the Best Bred-By-Exhibitor award is automatic. Example: An entry from the Bred-By-Exhibitor class is awarded Best of Winners or Best of Breed. Best Bred-by Exhibitor will be selected from the First-Place Winners of the Dog and Bitch Bred-by-Exhibitor classes, both Puppy & Adult. Only dog and bitches undefeated in a Bred-By-Exhibitor class are eligible for Best Bred-By-Exhibitor competition. If the first-place winner is not present, the second-place winner may not compete. NO ADDITIONAL FEE IS REQUIRED. Best Bred-by Exhibitor receives a prize of one free litter registration, donated by AKC.

**Best Veteran Competition:** During the course of regular judging, the assigned judge will select a Best Veteran from the Veteran Class winners. This will be done after the Best of Breed Competition, unless the Best Veteran award is automatic. Example: An entry from the Veteran class is awarded Best of Breed. Only dog and bitches undefeated in a Veteran class are eligible for Best Veteran competition. If the first-place winner is not present, the second-place winner may not compete. NO ADDITIONAL FEE IS REQUIRED.

---

## POINTS AVAILABLE FOR RESERVE

The Cardigan Welsh Corgi Club of America, Inc. will award at its National Specialty a three-point major to Reserve Winners Dog if the Regular Class Dog entry is twice the required number for a five-point major in the division where the National Specialty is held.

The Cardigan Welsh Corgi Club of America, Inc. will award at its National Specialty a three-point major to Reserve Winners Bitch if the Regular Class Bitch entry is twice the required number for a five-point major in the division where the National Specialty is held.

## NON-REGULAR CLASSES INVOLVING MULTIPLE DOG ENTRIES

As the judge's decision in the Stud Dog, Brood Bitch, & Brace classes are based on more than one dog or bitch, none of the dogs or bitches making up the entry judged first in these classes will be eligible to compete for Best of Breed by virtue of having won these classes.

**STUD DOG CLASS** is for Stud Dogs and two (2) of their Get. Stud Dogs must be entered in the Stud Dog Class and must be shown in the ring with their Get. The Stud Dog cannot be shown as the Get for another Stud Dog. Owner of Stud Dog need not necessarily be the owner of Get. Offspring only to be judged based on their merits. Dogs entered in this class need not be entered in another class; however, each dog making up the Get must be individually entered in one of the Regular Conformation Classes, Best of Breed Competition or a Non- Regular Conformation Class (*other than the Stud Dog Class*) at this show.

**BROOD BITCH CLASS**, same as for Stud Dog except substitute Brood Bitch for Stud Dog and Produce for Get where appropriate. A castrated male may be entered as the Stud Dog in the Stud Dog Class and a spayed bitch may be entered as the Brood Bitch in the Brood Bitch Class.

**BRACE CLASS**, for two dogs that are similar in appearance, performing in unison and presented by a maximum of two handlers. Dogs competing in brace competitions must have at least one common owner. Dogs need not be entered in another class. Brace Class must be indicated on the entry form. If more than one brace is entered by common owners, the dogs comprising each Brace Unit must be designated "Brace #1, Brace #2, etc". Indicate on each entry form the AKC number/Registered name of the other member of the brace.

### REQUIREMENTS

The Pee Wee Special Attraction is a pre-Junior Showmanship Class. The Pee Wee Class is geared toward children 5 to 9 years of age. Each Pee Wee unit consists of the child, their parent (or guardian, responsible adult), and the dog. Only one Pee Wee unit is in the ring at a time. This is not a competitive class, but rather a fun, learning experience for the child and the adult.

- A dog must be at least six months of age to enter the Pee Wee Class.
- The dog must be a Cardigan Welsh Corgi. We have plenty if you don't own one you can borrow one.
- Bitches in season will not be allowed to participate. If pre-entered, a dog may be substituted that meets the eligibility requirements as specified by the Club.
- All dogs entered must have the proper lead and collar.
- A responsible adult must be present with the child both inside and outside the ring. The adult is to maintain control of the dog outside of the ring.

THERE ARE NO RESTRICTIONS TO HANDLERS IN SWEEPSTAKES COMPETITION.

Sweepstakes winners do not go on to further placement in the shows as a result of participating.

Champions of record are eligible. **Neutered dogs and spayed bitches may be entered in Veteran Sweepstakes.** Indicate your entry in VETERAN SWEEPSTAKES on the entry form in the space provided for Additional Classes.

### FOUR-TO-SIX MONTH BEGINNER PUPPY COMPETITION

The Four-to-Six Month Puppy competition shall be for Cardigan Welsh Corgis that are four months of age and over but under six months on the day of the event. AKC registration number or an AKC litter number will be required for entries of an AKC recognized breed as listed in Chapter 3, Section 1 of the Rules Applying to Dog Shows. A foreign-born dog may enter this class if they are registered in the country of origin. All entrants are to be vaccinated (including rabies) in accordance with their veterinarian's protocol. Professional handlers, members of their household and current assistants may personally exhibit a dog they own as "Exhibition Only". Dogs that are owned or co-owned by a professional handler, member of their household and current assistant may compete for awards in this competition but must be handled by a non-professional handler.

Dogs and Bitches will compete together prior to the selection of Best of Breed & Best of Opposite Sex Beginner Puppy.

## JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP

**NOVICE CLASS:** For boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who at the time entries close have not won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class. A first place in Novice without competition leading to a Best Junior award with competition would count as one win towards moving to Open at a licensed or member show. Junior Handlers who win a third Novice Class with competition, if a win in Novice leads to a Best Junior with competition present it will count as one win towards moving to Open, after the closing of entries for a show are required to transfer their entry from the Novice Class to the Open Class by notifying the Show Secretary prior to the judging of the class at the show.

**OPEN CLASS:** For boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show, and who have won three first place awards in a Novice Class or if a win in Novice leads to a Best Junior with competition present it will count as one win towards moving to Open in a licensed or member show. Juniors which according to their records have completed the requirements to compete in the Open class but whose status is unconfirmed by the American Kennel Club are limited to competing in the Open Class for a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the Junior completed the requirements according to their records.

**MASTER CLASS:** This class will be for boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years on the day of the show, and who have 10 Best Junior wins with competition. The calendar for this class will be consistent with the eligibility dates for the AKC National Championship. All Juniors meeting the criteria for this class are required to enter the Master Class and may change their entry the day of the show if entries have already closed. Once the eligibility time frame for that year has passed all participants return to the Open Class to compete for the following year.

**NOVICE AND OPEN CLASS DIVIDED:**

- **Junior**-9 years old and under 12 years old on the day of the show
- **Intermediate**-12 years old and under 15 years old on the day of the show
- **Senior**-15 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show.

BEST JUNIOR HANDLER: Winners from each class will compete for Best Junior Handler.

NOTICE: Junior Handlers must include their AKC JUNIOR HANDLER NUMBER on each entry. You may obtain your junior identification number by calling the AKC, Judges Education Department, (919) 233-9767. BE SURE ALL INFORMATION for Junior Showmanship Classes is entered on front and back of entry form.

No entry may be changed or cancelled unless notice of the change or cancellation is received in writing by the Superintendent or Show Secretary named in the premium list to receive entries, prior to the closing date and hour for entries, except that a correction may be made from one age division to another, as well as, move from Master to Open or Open to Novice if a win has been disallowed or the Junior miscalculated number of placements, provided this transfer is made by the Superintendent or Show Secretary prior to the judging of the class at the show.

### AKC National Owner-Handled Series

*(Remember to check the box at the bottom of the entry form)*



The AKC National Owner-Handled Series is a non-titling competition for dogs that are exhibited by their owners that are not professional handlers. Exhibitors must declare their dog is Owner-Handled eligible at the time of entry using the check box on the entry form. Eligible dogs will be identified by an asterisk in the judge's book & the catalog. **Dogs must be handled throughout the breed level competition for the regular show by an eligible owner. Professional handlers, household members and current assistants\*\* to professional handlers may not exhibit the dog in this competition.**

Owner-Handled Best of Breed will be selected from the dogs that are eligible to compete in the Best of Breed competition including Winners Dog, Winners Bitch and undefeated winners of the non-regular classes. This excludes all dogs defeated during class and winners competition for the regular show.

- If the Best of Breed/Variety winner is Owner-Handled competition eligible, it will automatically be Owner-Handled Best of Breed/Variety.
- If the Best of Breed/Variety winner is not eligible for Owner-Handled competition and the Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed/Variety is eligible, the Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed/Variety will compete against the eligible exhibits of the other sex to determine Owner-Handled Best of Breed/Variety.
- If neither the Best of Breed/Variety nor the Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed/Variety are Owner-Handled competition eligible and Select Dog & Select Bitch are both eligible, the judge is to choose Best Owner-Handled exhibit from the Selects and eligible Winners Dog or Winners Bitch.
- If one of the Selects is eligible, excuse all Champions and non-regular class winners of the same sex and then choose Best Owner-Handled exhibit from the remaining dogs of the opposite sex including the eligible Winners.
- If Best of Breed/Variety, Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed/Variety, Select Dog & Select Bitch are not eligible, the judge may choose any eligible dog who competed in Best of Breed/Variety including Winners Dog or Winners Bitch as the Best of Breed/Variety for the AKC National Owner-Handled Series.
- If the Best of Winners is eligible, the other Winner is ineligible since it was defeated.
- No class dogs other than the Winners Dog & Winners Bitch are eligible to return to the ring.

\* Professional handlers are defined as any person who belongs or has belonged to a professional handlers' organization, distributed rate cards, or otherwise advertised or represented themselves as handling dogs for pay within the last five years.

\*\*A current assistant is defined as anyone employed by a professional handler on a full-time basis, or, assisting a professional handler at the show or any show during the cluster/weekend

## CWCCA RULES AND REGULATIONS

### NOTICE TO DOG OWNERS, EXHIBITORS AND HANDLERS

When you or your agent sign the entry form, you automatically agree to the following terms concerning your stay in any hotel or motel during the duration of our Specialty. Exhibitors with recreational vehicles should follow the rules as applicable. These rules have been established for the good of all exhibitors and to help maintain good relationships between the dog show community and hotel and motels.

1. Plastic sheeting **MUST** be placed under every crate in a hotel/motel room. This will keep carpets clean and dry. It is the responsibility of each exhibitor to provide their own plastic sheeting.
2. Dogs must be crated when owner is out of the room. **NO EXCEPTIONS!**
3. Dogs must be kept on leash at all times while in the hotel/motel, lobbies or on the hotel/motel grounds with the exception of dogs in exercise pens or performance dogs practicing, warming up or trialing.
4. No grooming or bathing of dogs in any guestroom. Bathing may only be done in the designated bathing area. Exhibitors must supply their own shampoo and towels. Hotel/motel towels may not be used for bathing dogs.
5. The hotel/motel management may choose to remove all bedspreads from guestrooms occupied with dogs. Guests should provide sheets or covers for all beds and sofas or chairs in their rooms to avoid significant dog hair accumulation on the furniture.
6. Hotel/motel guests are requested to voluntarily report damages when and if it occurs. Rooms will be inspected daily by members of the hotel/motel staff & observed violations or damages will be reported to the hotel/motel management and/or the Specialty Event Committee.
7. Dogs should only be "exercised" in designated areas on motel premises. Every dog owner is expected to pick up after their own dog(s) & dispose of waste in designated trash cans. Failure to do so should be reported to the Specialty Event Committee. Observe "no dogs" posted areas. It is the responsibility of the dog owner/ agent to find out from the hotel's staff where these areas and cans are located if not clearly marked. Do not allow your dog to urinate or defecate on the hotel/motel buildings, or on the landscaped areas of the hotel. Violations will be reported to the Specialty Event Committee.
8. Due to health regulations and the presence of non-dog owning guests at hotels, dogs are not allowed near food service areas or any area posted as prohibited. No dogs are allowed in the restaurant, lounge, pool or pool area, fitness center, meeting rooms (without club approval) or public restrooms.
9. Do not let your dog become a nuisance to your neighbor. There will be non-dog guests at the hotel. Excessive barking will be reported to the Specialty Event Committee and repeat violators may be asked to leave.
10. RV parking will be in an area designated at Show Site. RV Parking at the specialty is by prior reservation only. Contact Clay Rhoten at [Clayton.Rhoten@marriott.com](mailto:Clayton.Rhoten@marriott.com)
11. RVers are expected to keep their parking area neat and clean at all times.
12. Each dog owner/agent/guest is expected to cooperate with the hotel/motel and/or Specialty Event Committee.
13. Dog owners/agents/room registrants will be financially responsible for damage to hotel/motel rooms caused by their dog(s) or themselves. This includes, but not limited to replacement cost for carpeting if odors or stains cannot be removed by traditional cleaning methods.
14. Dog owners/agents/room registrants/RVers are expected to settle damage claims on the spot, or else must be willing to furnish information, such as insurance policy numbers & other pertinent information as required/ requested.
15. Any guest found not to be following the above rules may be asked to leave the hotel/motel without a refund. Should a hotel/motel, for cause, deem it necessary to cancel room privileges, the registrant agrees to forgo legal actions against the CWCCA & the hotel/motel.
16. Exhibitors understand and agree that violations may be referred to the Specialty Event Committee if written charges are filed. If such charges are upheld by the Specialty Event Committee, it may lead to suspension from future show privileges.

18. The hotel/motel and Specialty Event Committee reserve the privilege of enacting additional rules as situations require.

- Grooming reservations will close when entries close or when full. Please be sure to reserve early as spaces are first come first served. Spaces **must vacated by May 16<sup>th</sup> at 11:00 pm.**
- Please submit any requests for set up (location, special needs, other people in the group, etc.) in the comment section of the reservation. We try to take all these into consideration but cannot guarantee all preferences can be met.

- **REQUIRED** crate tags can be picked up at the Welcome Table.

These values are evident across all aspects of the sport: conformation, performance, companion, and family dog activities. Many believe that the enduring principles of sportsmanship and civility are key reasons the sport has thrived for over 140 years. Recognizing that periodically reaffirming our shared values strengthens our community, the revised code will be shared widely to highlight the foundational values and principles that define the sport.

- Sportspeople always place the welfare of their dog above all else.
- Sportspeople prioritize the long-term health and preservation of their breed, making decisions that reflect a deep commitment to responsible breeding and ownership.
- Sportspeople respect the history, traditions and integrity of the sport of purebred dogs.
- Sportspeople conduct themselves in a manner that reflects positively on the sport, the American Kennel Club, and themselves.
- Sportspeople appreciate, encourage and support all who associate with and participate in the sports by fostering an environment where respect, equity, inclusion, and courtesy are foundational.
- Sportspeople understand, uphold and abide by all AKC bylaws, rules, regulations and policies.
- Sportspeople contribute to a positive atmosphere at events by avoiding negative gossip, disparagement, or unsportsmanlike behavior.
- Sportspeople extend their values of civility, fairness, and respect to all digital and social media platforms.
- Sportspeople actively support the education and mentorship of newcomers, helping them learn the rules, values, and traditions of the sport in a respectful way.
- Sportspeople recognize that they are role models in the sport, and strive to lead by example through humility, kindness, and ethical conduct.
- Sportspeople treat fellow exhibitors, judges, officials, volunteers, spectators, and AKC staff with dignity and respect, regardless of experience, background, or differences in opinion.
- Sportspeople are committed to fair play, honesty, courtesy, and competition, approaching both winning and losing with grace.
- Sportspeople understand that strong competition and civility can—and should—coexist. They appreciate the quality of their competitors, and the effort put forth by others.
- Sportspeople uphold their responsibilities to the sport of purebred dogs and refuse to let personal gain or self-interest influence their decisions or behavior.
- The sportsperson judges only on the merits of the dogs and considers no other factors.
- The sportsperson judge or exhibitor accepts constructive criticism.
- The sportsperson exhibitor declines to enter or exhibit under a judge where it might reasonably appear that the judge's placements could be based on something other than the merits of the dogs.
- The sportsperson exhibitor refuses to compromise the impartiality of a judge.
- Sportspeople are willing to share honest and open appraisals of both the strengths and weaknesses of their breeding stock.
- Sportspeople decline to exploit any positions of authority or recognition for personal advantage.
- Sportspeople appreciate those that have gone before them and realize they are responsible for maintaining and enhancing the sport for future generations.

1. Entries must reach the Show Secretary, DogZibit, P. O. Box 2044, Woodinville, WA 98072-2044 by the closing date & time specified in the Premium List. After which time no entries can be accepted, canceled, changed, substituted, corrected, completed or signed and no entry fees refunded. Any change or cancellation must be made in writing and received prior to closing, except as provided in Chapter 11, Section 6 of the American Kennel Club Dog Show Rules and Regulations. Fees must accompany entries; DogZibit assumes no responsibility for cash sent through the mail. The Club and/or DogZibit assumes no responsibility for wrong or incomplete information given on the entry blank by the owner or agent of the owner.
2. No Entry will be accepted which specifies any condition as to its acceptance. Telegraph, FAX and unsigned entries cannot be accepted. Entries not on Official AKC Entry Forms and photocopies of entry forms without Agreement and Rules on reverse side are **not acceptable**. Exhibitors are admonished to make themselves familiar with this agreement. Rule books may be obtained from the AKC, 5580 Centerview Dr., Raleigh, NC 27606. The Club and/or DogZibit assumes no responsibility for incorrect or incomplete information given on the entry blank by the owner or the owner's agent which includes entering a dog in a class which the dog is not eligible to compete. **Responsibility for completeness of entry rests solely with entrant.**
3. **Returned checks** do not constitute a valid entry fee. DogZibit will add a \$30.00 collection fee to the amount of each returned check. We will not re-process checks. The exhibitor will be contacted & required to send a money order for the original amount PLUS the \$30.00 NSF fee. Subsequent returned checks from same person may result in their being put on a CASH ONLY BASIS.
4. **Exhibitors' entry acknowledgements** will be made as soon as practicable by email to the address given on the entry blank. If not received by the end of the closing date, notify DogZibit. Judging programs will be sent at least a week prior to the show.
5. **No refunds of entry fees** when a dog is absent, disqualified, sick, lame, excused by the Judge or Veterinarian, or barred from competition by action of the Show Committee, or because it has been entered incorrectly. There is no refund for duplicate entries or overpayments. If because of riots, wars, strikes, civil disturbances, national emergencies, health emergencies, and the dictates of law enforcement or of the owner(s) of the grounds and/or facilities or other acts beyond the control of the management it is impossible to open or to complete the event, no refund of entry fee will be made. Extreme weather conditions, such as, but not limited to snow storms, hurricanes, lightning, extreme heat, heavy rains, or other circumstances including, but not limited to, the condition of the facilities or grounds and/or the ingress and egress from the grounds, must be considered for the health and safety of the dogs, exhibitors and spectators.
