Make checks and money orders payable (in U.S. Funds) to the **CWCCA** and mail to the Test Secretary. You will be notified by phone or email within 24 hours after the draw. Please include either or both so that I can contact you. Entries need to be on an official AKC form, signed and with the entry fee.

DRAWING FOR TRACKS:

The Judges will assemble the participants in the test headquarters at the regional airport for a drawing by lot for the track number of each participant. The time for each draw will be stated in the judging program. The order in which tracks are run and the number of each track shall be determined by the Tracking Judges. Judging will begin as soon as possible after the draws.

PRIZES: Each passing team shall receive a rosette and a gift card.

INCIDENTALS:

Please join us for lunch following the test. According to AKC regulations, you must keep your dogs on leash at all times and, of course, please pick up your poop if it is in a place someone might find it later! The CWCCA does not agree to arbitrate claims as set forth in the official AKC entry form and while the CWCCA will exercise reasonable care for the safety of dogs, handlers and spectators, it will not be responsible for any loss, damage or injury to any dog or person on the trial grounds.

DRAWING OF ENTRIES:

Entries shall be accepted up until the official closing date, even though the advertised limits have been reached. **Please do not send an entry that requires a signature for acceptance. I am not always at home!** Entries will be drawn by the Test Secretary on **Wednesday, April 13 at 6 PM at her home!** The drawing shall be completely random among each entry group, whichever test is entered. **Preference in both tests will be given to Cardigan Welsh Corgis.** The draw order shall be: Cardigans without a title, Cardigans with a title, others without a title then others with a title, according to AKC Tracking rules for specialties. When the advertised limit has been drawn all remaining entries, subject to the same preferences set forth above, shall be assigned a position on the Alternate List corresponding to the order in which they were drawn. In the event that either test does not fill a TDX can be exchanged for 2 TD's and vice versa.

ENTRY REFUNDS:

Entries that pass an AKC approved test after the closing date of this test may withdraw from this test with full refund provided the test secretary is notified before the test date and there is an alternate to replace the entry. Call me as soon as you know! Those who decline to be placed on the alternate list shall have their entry fees returned or destroyed in my shredder. Any dog that makes the draw but cannot run may also have their fees returned only if an alternate competes in their place.

ENTRY FEES SHALL NOT BE REFUNDED:

In the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by a Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by action of the Show Committee. Exhibitors are governed by rules and regulations of the AKC and local ordinances. The well-being of the exhibitors, dogs and spectators is of paramount importance. In the event it is necessary to cancel or stop the event before completion, no refund of entry will be made.

ALTERNATE ENTRIES:

If an accepted entry is absent on the day of the test, it shall be the responsibility of the Test Secretary to determine if any alternates are present. Alternates will draw for available tracks based on their place on the alternate list. If no alternates are present the judges will designate someone to draw for the absent dog, which may run the track if it arrives before the track is scheduled to be run. If it does not arrive by then it will be marked absent.

IMPORTANT NOTICES REGARDING USE OF THE TEST SITE

Permission to use properties in and around Sullivan, Missouri is for this Tracking Test only. Exhibitors wanting to practice at the site must secure their own permission from the Parks and Recreation Department. Practicing at the site within three (3) days of the test is prohibited. All dogs must be on lead at all times. Animals are **NOT** allowed in the building at any time. We ask that you use the dedicated exercise area when possible and always clean up your dog's waste.

RISK: The owner or agent entering a dog in a Tracking Test does so at his/ her own risk and agrees to abide by all of the Rules and Regulations of the American Kennel Club. INSTRUCTIONS

- (Variety)* if you are entering a dog of breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering, i.e., Cocker Spaniel (*solid color black, ASCOB, parti-color*), Beagles (*not exceeding 13 in., over 13 in. but not exceeding 15 in.*), Dachshunds (*longhaired, smooth, wirehaired*), Collies (*rough, smooth*), Bull Terriers (*colored, white*), Manchester Terriers (*standard, toy*), Chihuahuas (*smooth coat, long coat*), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (*toy, miniature, standard*).
- The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which, according to their owners' records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.
- (Event Class)* Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e, age division, color division, weight division.
- A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his/her name.
