## ENTRY LIMITS/NUMBER OF STOCK USED PER RUN; OUTFUN

**Livestock:** Sheep Course A & B (3-5 head), Sheep Course C (20-25 head) hair and hair/wool crosses;  
Ducks Courses A & B (5 head – mixed breed)

**Entries - Test and Trial** – Limited to 50 runs per day, all courses and stock.

**Course B:** Outruns will be the minimum.

**Course C:** Limited to 6 advanced runs per day, or 8 runs per day with maximum of 5 advanced runs.

## ENTRY FEES FOR TEST AND TRIAL

**\$50.00 for Courses A & B (sheep and ducks); \$50.00 for Course C (sheep); and \$45.00 Tests (tests are sheep only)**

(Entry fee includes \$3.50 AKC recording fee). No dog may be entered in two classes on the same course with the same kinds of stock and under the same judge at any test/trial. ***Cardigan Welsh Corgi will receive entry preference from January 31, 2018, until February 22, 2018.***

## **DIRECTIONS TO TRIAL SITE**

From North or South I-5 to Hwy 16 in Tacoma. Hwy 16 begins at I-5, crosses the Narrows Bridge and travels toward Bremerton.

Take Hwy 16 past Gig Harbor. Exit at sign for Hwy 302W (Purdy/Shelton). Follow exit road into Purdy to the traffic light. Turn left at the signal following sign for Hwy 302W (Shelton/Key Center) -- you will cross the Wauna Bridge. Continue to follow Gig Harbor-Longbranch Hwy (5.2 m) to the junction with Hwy 302 at the 2nd signal. (*NOTE: At some point along here you will likely lose cell phone service.*)

At the signal, go right (turn lane-right turn only) onto Elgin-Clifton Rd following sign for Hwy 302W (Shelton/Allyn). Turn right onto 150th. Turn left on 1st road (at the end of the chain link fence). No street sign, but marked with a large sign that says "Rocky Creek Conservation Area". Follow road through the park. When you exit the trees, there will be a green farm gate directly in front of you which is the entrance to the facility.

ENTRY FEE for ducks and sheep Courses A & B is \$50.00; entry fee for Course C sheep is \$50.00' and the entry fee for tests is \$45.00. All fees include \$3.50 AKC recording fee. ENTRIES WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED WITHOUT FEES.

ENTRIES CLOSE at the Herding Test/Trial Secretary's office, as follows: **Closing date inclusion in the CWCCA national catalog is March 28, 2018. Closing date for ALL entries is Friday, April 6, 2018,** or when numerical limits are reached if prior to that date, after which time entries cannot be accepted, canceled, altered or substituted.

DRAWING for running order will be held at 555 Blue Sky Drive, Port Townsend, WA 98368, on Saturday, April 7, 2018, at 6:30 PM.

ENTRY FORMS MUST BE SIGNED by the owner or the owner's duly authorized agent, otherwise entry cannot be accepted.

MAKE CHECKS OR MONEY ORDERS payable to CWCCA All fees are payable in U.S. Funds.

RETURNED CHECKS do not constitute a valid entry. A collection fee of \$25.00 will be added to each returned check.

ERRORS ON ENTRY FORMS. ENTRY FEES SHALL NOT BE REFUNDED in the event a dog is absent, not allowed to compete in the entered class, disqualified, excused, by a Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by action of Show Committee, or if because of riots, civil disturbances, or other acts beyond the control of the management it is impossible to open or complete the Test/Trial, no refund of entry fee will be made.

BITCHES IN SEASON will be permitted to run. In the test classes they will be placed at the end of the running order within the class

ALL DOGS PRESENT MUST BE HELD ON LEASH or otherwise restricted except when in the exercise ring. Under no circumstances will dogs be allowed to disturb the resting stock or interfere outside the arena with another dog's performance in the arena. See Chapter 1, Section 20 of the AKC Herding Regulations.

EXPRESS ENTRIES – If you send your entries via any type of express mail you MUST waive recipient signature. If not, there is no guarantee that entry will be picked up in a timely manner.

Owners or their Agents are solely responsible for the presence of their dog(s) at the Test/Trial arena. Judges are not required to wait for dogs, but every effort will be made to accommodate exhibitors.

Exhibitors are expected to maintain the premises in a clean, tidy condition and to pick up after their dogs.

Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations
