Dogs Eligible to Enter This trial is open to all Cardigan Welsh Corgis 15 months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration or Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP). Dogs should be physically sound. Bitches in season, aggressive, blind or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance are ineligible to participate.

Glory Run: The Glory Run will be held 15 minutes after Trial #2. Dogs participating in the Glory Runs may NOT be entered in either trial and must be ambulatory. Entries at: <https://cwcca.club/ns/events/agility-glory-runs/>

Notice to Exhibitors

- ALL CRATES MUST BE ON A MAT
- The safety of the dogs is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.
- Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, lame or barred from competition by action of the Trial Committee or Judge
- No entry will be refunded if the trial cannot be opened or completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.
- It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dog and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Trial Committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such case, no refund of any fees will be made.
- Exhibitors are responsible for complete, accurate, and legible information on their entry forms; illegible or incomplete entries cannot be entered into the show. All entries must be made on Official AKC Entry Forms or copies and must include the Agreement and Rules. No Entry shall be made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any condition as to its acceptance.
- Handlers may opt to run in a higher height division, but not in a division lower than their proper height division. Dogs entered in the Preferred classes may not run in a higher height division.
- Bitches in season and injured dogs are not permitted to compete in Agility Trials. Entry fees will be refunded less a \$10 processing fee per run with a certificate from a veterinarian.
- All dogs must be on leash at all times except when in the ring or when in the designated agility warm-up area. Judges are not required to wait for dogs. The owner or handler of each dog is solely responsible for having it ready at ringside when its class is to be judged.
- Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their own dogs. Please help us keep this site clean for future use.
- Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. The Club Treasurer will add a collection fee as assessed by the bank, minimum of \$35, to the amount of each returned check. Subsequent returned checks from the same exhibitor may result in their being put on a cash only basis.
- Concessions will be available on site.

- The show site will be available to exhibitors for set up on Monday at 7:00 AM as outlined in the Notice to all Exhibitors.
- Course Familiarization and Warm-Ups Handlers in all classes are permitted to walk the course, without a dog, prior to the start of the class. The walk-through period allows handlers to plan their strategy running the course and will be held prior to each class, following the judge's briefing.
- Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.

Wait List

CWCCA is offering a Wait List to fill openings created by withdrawn entries after the trial's closing Wednesday, April 10, 2019 at 6:00 pm. A maximum of 20 entries will be placed on the club's wait list. All entries, including wait listed entries, must be received by the Trial Secretary prior to Wednesday, April 10, 2019 at 6:00 pm. Any entries withdrawn that are received by Wednesday, April 10, 2019 will be replaced by a wait listed entry if any are available. If a withdrawn entry is replaced by a wait listed entry, a full refund will be issued for the withdrawn entry. Any wait listed entry that does not move off the wait list into the trial by April 29, 2019 will receive a full refund. A dog withdrawn from the wait list before April 29, 2019 will receive a full refund.

Criteria for the HIGH IN TRIAL

Qualifying scores in both Standard (STD) & Jumpers with Weaves (JWW) classes of the same trial are required. Each dog will be assigned points based on the STD class ENTERED for that trial (30 for Ex/Mas; 20 for Open; 10 for Novice). These points are added to the dog's speed points (judge's course time minus the dog's course time) plus the dog's score for each course. The dogs with the most points are HIGH IN TRIAL.

No Double Qs? Then Standard runs only will be used in the formulation of HIGH IN TRIAL.

Each Q will receive a Q cookie

Each dog entered will receive a toy
Each handler will receive a logo item

INSTRUCTIONS

Handlers may opt to enter in a higher **height division** for all **Regular** titling classes, but not in a division lower than their proper height division. Dogs entered in the **Preferred** classes **must** compete at the required jump height and **may not** compete in a jump height division **higher or lower** than their proper height division.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an **Agility Jump Height Card** may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. If measured by the Judge of record, that measurement will be valid for this trial *or back-to-back trials* only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.

Dogs listed in the **AKC Canine Partners** SM program may be eligible to enter all-breed AKC agility trials at the club's option. These dogs should be listed as All American Dog and must include their AKC number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box.

Junior Handlers should enter their Junior Handler number on the front of this form. Should you not have your Junior Handler number, it may be obtained from the American Kennel Club (919) 233-9767. If the Junior Handler is not the owner of the dog identified on the face of this form, what is the relationship of the Junior Handler to the Owner? _____
