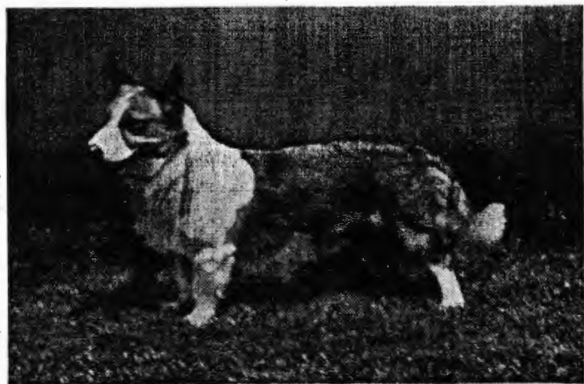

DESCRIPTION OF THE CARDIGAN WELSH CORGI

The Cardigan Welsh Corgi is a comparatively small but hardy dog, and is almost as old as Welsh history. Practically unknown, he survived through the centuries among the small hill-farms of Cardiganshire. To this day he is seen rounding up cattle as the mists descend upon the valleys, and at night curled up in front of the peat fire of the little white-washed cottage with its earthen floor. Some twenty-three years ago, however, he gained official recognition and soon after appeared on the show bench. In September 1934 the Kennel Club decreed he should have his own register, which had hitherto been shared with Pembroke. About a yard long, he is built on powerful lines, standing around 12 inches from the ground with his forelegs slightly bowed. His head is foxy in shape, with a good width of skull, and the eyes, preferably dark in color, give a sharp and watchful expression. He is found in a variety of beautiful colors—blue merle, black, black and tan, brindle, red and sable, with usually an admixture of white. He possesses a weather-resisting coat of medium length which needs little attention. His friendliness and adaptability make him a delightful companion and with children he has shown an extraordinary capacity for affection and loyalty.
